

INVISALIGN

ATTACHMENTS:

Most patients require attachments with their treatment to assist with certain tooth movements. These are small, tooth coloured "bumps". Size, position and quantity vary from patient to patient.

POLISHING AND CONTOURING:

Sometime this is required to create additional space or improve the contact points for your teeth



ELASTICS:

Some patients require elastics to **complement their treatment for** bite correction.



CHECK-UPS:

You change your aligners yourself every 2 weeks and come back for a check-up approximately every 6-8 weeks

REFINEMENTS:

There are typically two phases to an Invisalign treatment. The first phase is straightening your teeth and the second phase is called 'refinement'. If **further correction is needed**, we may ask you to come back in for a scan and order additional aligners

RETENTION:

An important part of your treatment which is designed to **prevent your teeth reverting back** to their original position.



Orthodontics is a team effort involving yourself and your orthodontist - care of your teeth, gums and appliances, regular attendance to your appointments and cooperation with such things as elastics will result in an excellent finish
